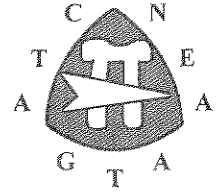

Protect Teacher Jobs and Student Class Size!

On January 25, 2011, GTA Representative Council took a position of **“No” on Measure S.**

Why did GTA Reps take this position?

- 1) IN AN EFFORT TO SAVE UP TO 120 JOBS OF OUR COLLEAGUES.
- 2) In June, a special statewide election will take place asking Californians to vote for a 5 year extension on the temporary tax increases now assessed. If the temporary tax extension does not pass, State revenues will be reduced and our school district **will lose \$8 Million Dollars per year.**
- 3) This projected loss could mean up to 120 GUSD teachers being laid-off.
- 4) Measure S bond money **cannot** be used to retain teachers to keep for class size reasonable..
- 5) If the June temporary tax increase continuance is not passed, to keep class sizes reasonable (and keep teacher jobs) would require the GUSD going to the citizens of Glendale and asking for a parcel tax or sales transaction tax increase.
- 6) While infrastructure is important, avoiding layoffs of up to 120 teachers is even more important. Now is not the time to risk overextending Glendale taxpayers.
- 7) Teachers and parents agree that class size is our number one priority.
- 8) We must prepare for the worst and take action now to SAVE JOBS. If we pass the 40 year tax measure of Measure S, passing another tax that would be used for class size and saving jobs would be nearly impossible.
