## Supporting Quarantined Students

**When students are quarantined, their absences are excused. Unless they are placed on short-term Independent Study, quarantined students should receive the same support as students who are absent due to illness, emergency, or school events. Schools will no longer receive ADA funding through distance learning or concurrent instruction.**

Per California Ed Code, Section 48205:

*A pupil absent from school [with an excused absence] shall be allowed to complete all assignments and tests missed during the absence that can be reasonably provided and, upon satisfactory completion within a reasonable period of time, shall be given full credit therefor. The teacher of the class from which a pupil is absent shall determine which tests and assignments shall be reasonably equivalent to, but not necessarily identical to, the tests and assignments that the pupil missed during the absence.*

### **Required Support for Quarantined Students**

- Provide assignments similar or identical to classwork
- Set due dates for student work that allow enough time for students to complete assignments *after* they return to school
- Provide tests/quizzes similar or identical to those in class
- Award credit for students' performance on assignments, tests, or quizzes without penalty
- Respond to students and parents by email or phone in a timely manner

### **Optional Support for Quarantined Students**

- Mail home packets
- Provide Zoom office hours
- Reteach or record lessons during direct instruction
- Set up a separate Google Classroom for absent students
- Assign work for all days of the quarantine
- Provide concurrent instruction
- Live Stream the class
